TOP TIPS

Get a free flu vaccine if you are pregnant, are aged 65 years or over, have a long term health condition, or are a carer. Children aged 2 or 3 years should also have it.

Talk to a pharmacist at the first sign of an illness, don't wait for things to get worse.

Call NHS 111 for an assessment over the phone if you need urgent help.

Call 999 if someone is seriously ill or injured.

Going to hospital by ambulance does not get you seen any quicker.

If you don't need us anymore, call 999 to cancel the ambulance.
